SAFE PLACE, a program sponsored by the non-religious Samaritans of New York, provides free support groups twice a month at convenient Manhattan locations for those who have lost a loved one to suicide.

SAFE PLACE MEETINGS are designed to provide suicide survivors with a supportive environment where they can talk about their thoughts and feelings and share their experiences tied to their loss in the company of people who are coping with the same emotions and problems.

THE MEETINGS are only for those who have lost a loved one to suicide. No one else is allowed to attend. Participants must be at least 18 years of age. To receive detailed information on meeting sites, days and times:
